

Founded in 1974, the Taekwondo Kukkiwon Demonstration Team is the Kukkiwon's primary tool in its efforts to promote the sport and Korea's national image overseas.

Composed of 70 of Korea's top taekwondo practitioners, this team has visited over 100 countries so far in order to introduce and spread Taekwondo and the Korean culture world wide. Such performances enhance Taekwondo's global appeal and the value of Korean culture.

In addition, the team presents a new model of Taekwondo demonstration that sticks to the traditional ways but at the same time adapts to changes whenever necessary.

It also contributes to the tourism industry by planning and performing regular demonstrations for international tourists visiting Korea.

Kukkiwon, the Center of Taekwondo Culture

Kukkiwon as the World Taekwondo Headquarters has vitalized Taekwondo in the form of the leading martial art by globalizing it since its foundation 1972.



It laid the groundwork for Taekwondo's globalization by holding the 1st World Taekwondo Championships and establishing the World Taekwondo Federation(WTF) in 1973.

Kukkiwon devotes itself to spread Taekwando culture, spirit and history worldwide, increasing the best competitive power of Taekwando as a martial art in life.

Proclamations of Taekwondo Kukkiwon Day

The Provincial Proclamation of Taekwondo Kukkiwon Day in B.C. was the first of its kind.

This initiative was made possible by the joint effort of the Korean Cultural Heritage Festival and the B.C. Taekwondo Federation when city wide Proclamations were granted in the cities of Burnaby, Vancouver, and North Vancouver.







Performance & Performer

Poongmul-Nori

Among various Korean performing arts, Pungmul-Nori is the most dynamic and traditional one. With drum beats and dance movements, it sketches beautiful Korean nature. Nori consists of different traditional dances such as Pan-gut, Sogonorum, Buh-na-norum, Saja-norum, and so on.

Korea Intangible Heritage Educational Development Institute

Korea Intangible heritage Educational Development Institute (Director of Art: Keun Soo Yang) which was established in 2008, is an organization with 25 traditional artists focusing on transmitting, distributing and developing Korean Intangible Heritage Educational Contents as well as producing Korean Intangible Heritage Performance.

It has recently been registered at UNESCO as Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity. It also successfully arranged two consecutive yearly festivals in 2014 and 2015 with total of 11 traditional performances including Namsadang-Nori, Yeongsanjae, Ganggangsulae, Pansori, Gesang, Taekkyeon, Tightrope walking, Nongak, Arirang, Gangneung Danoje Festival and Cheoyongmu. Moreover, the festival will continue to happen again in this year at Buyeo Baekje Cultural Complex.

최근에는 UNESCO 인류무형유산에 등재되어 있으며, 공연이 가능한 남사당놀이, 영산재, 강강술래, 판소리, 가곡, 택견, 줄타기, 농악, 아리랑, 강릉단오제, 처용무등 11개 종목을 모야 2014년과 2015년에 2년간 축제를 만들었으며, 2017년 올해에도 부여 백제문화단지에서 열릴 예정이다.

Arirang Party

This is restructured Korean performance based on Arirang rhythm that represents Korea with Korean traditional music, drum and Taekwondo.

Youngjoo Julie Kim

Julie, master of Korean traditional dance, majored Korean tradition dance at CHUNG -ANG UNIVERSITY which is one of the top institutions for Korean traditional dance school and she finished her master degree at same university.

She has performed Korean traditional dance in various events in Korea (17th President Inauguration ceremony, TV programs), US (Ministry of National Defense Military Band Competition), Canada (Korea – Canada 50th-year Diplomatic Relation ceremony), Japan (Kagosima / Osaka Summer Festival) and Vietnam (Korea – Vietnam 25th-year Diplomatic Relation ceremony). She has been performing in various events in Canada last 3 years to spread the Excellency of Korean culture to Canadian society. She loves to continue her career in Canada to share our culture to diverse ethnic communities until she can play her performance.

Recently, Kyung Hee Taekwondo Demo. Team won at 2015 & 2016 Pan America Taekwondo Championship in United States. The Team's remarkable effort is

allowing the growth of Taekwondo in Greater Vancouver.

3 Dynamic Drumming 'Inform to the sky'

With 3 dynamic rhythm beats made by Dae-buk (big drum) and other smaller drums, the drumming sends a message to the gods above the sky.

다이나믹 3북연주 '하늘에 고함' : 3개의 화려한 북 가락이 주축이 되어 대북과 나머지 북이 어울려 흥과 힘을 하늘에 고하는 작품이다.

While the Korean oboe plays, the performers parade around the stage in a prayer for a bumper crop. The tune is from farmer's music, and the dance is an expression of the desire to avoid bad luck and welcome good luck.

길놀이: 피리가 농악을 연주하고, 다른 이들은 풍작을 기원하는 춤을 춘다. 길놀이 음악은 농부들에게서 전래되어 왔고, 불행을 피하고 복을 기원 하는 것을 춤으로 표현한다.



Van Namsadang, Korean traditional music organization with 20 performers has been established in 2012 and recently educates and performs Korean traditional music performance. They have performed more than 150 times as diversified traditional art genre. They are focusing on Korean culture diffusion to Canadian society and build relationships between Korean culture and other cultures in Canada.

밴남사당은 2011년 설립되어 현재 20여명의 회원으로 구성되어 있는 한국전통음악문화교육 및 공연을 주로 하는 국악전문 공연단체이다. 다양한 전통예술 쟝르로 150여 차례의 공연을 해 왔으며, 캐나다 지역사회에 한국 음악문화의 멋을 소개하고 이를 통하여 한인과 타민족 간의 소통과 화합의 매개 역할을 하고자 한다.



Samgo-Mu

Samgo-Mu is a korean traditional dance genre with colorful and various techniques, with dancers with three drums hung on the square frames laid out in a triangle form. 삼고무: 승무의 북춤에서 발전된 한국 춤의 일종으로 세 개의 북 가운데에 무용수가 춤을 추며 다양한 북가락과 몸짓으로 조화를 이루어가는 대표적인 한국무용이다.



Taepyeong-Mu

Taepyeong-Mu is one of Korean traditional dance forms occasionally performed by king or queen for the peaceful reign and the prosperity of the nation.

태평무: 왕실의 번영과 나라의 태평성대를 기원하기 위하여 왕비 또는 왕이 직접 춤을 춘다는 내용을 담은 한국의 춤이다.

Charm Dance Company

Charm dance company is a BC based non-profit dance organization with four Korean dancers from semi-professional to professional. Last 2 years of performing, we become one of representative Korean Dance Company in Metro Vancouver

K-POP (Korean pop music) is a musical genre originating in South Korea that is characterized by a wide variety of audio visual elements.

It could comprise all genres of "popular music" within South Korea, but the term is more often used in a narrower sense to describe a modern form of South Korean pop music covering a range of styles including dance-pop, pop ballad, R&B and hip-hop music.

On July 22, the K-pop competition semi final happened at the Korean Cultural Center in Vancouver. There were fifty four groups and soloists who preformed and twenty-three will move on to the finals at the 16th annual Korean Cultural Heritage Festival. The participants varied in ages, cultural backround and some even had their own song and choreography which proves that K-pop has a very dynamic effect and has taken an international toll.
